Teachers are needed from Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne's, Talbot, Caroline, Dorchester, Wicomico, Somerset, and Worcester Counties to learn, develop, and implement an environmental education/marine science summer program. Field and classroom activities will be developed and tried out with students in the program. Employment or credit is available for the in service and program.

- Positions Available: Teachers at \$160 per Day of Camp
Teachers will participate in training sessions and teaching/activity development during program.
- Teacher In-service: 1st: July 9, 2010 9:00am to 1:00pm
(tentative) 2nd: July 23, 2010 9:00am to 1:00 pm (if needed)
- Student Program Dates: August 2 - August 6, 2010
- Accommodations/Meals: Horn Point Environmental Education Center. Participants will sleep in dormitories and meals will be provided in the Dining Hall.
- Teacher Responsibilities: Each teacher will: Attend in-service training/ planning sessions, teach students in summer program and be present on overnights to assist with supervision and instruction.
- Teacher Qualifications: Be currently employed and plan to continue employment as a teacher in one of the above school systems. Be willing to work in the outdoors and engage in group planning and teaching.
- Application Deadline: June 18, 2010. Selected applicants will be notified by July 1, 2010.
- To Apply: Write a letter explaining your interest in the program. Include: Current teaching situation, Fields of interest, Background, Experience with active teaching and outdoor education and any special skills.
